Common questions

Who is eligible?

To qualify for Aetna Medicare Direct, you must be:

- Currently enrolled in Medicare Part A and/or B
- Covered under your former company's medical plan (your secondary carrier)*

Do I need to file a claim?

No, you don't have to do anything. Once your provider files a claim, we take care of rest. And you'll see it noted on your Medicare Explanation of Benefits (EOB).

What if I receive care in other locations?

Your claims will be processed no matter where you are — even if you receive health care in two different states.

How do I ensure my claim was filed?

Your Medicare EOB should include a sentence similar to "unpaid charges have been forwarded to your secondary carrier." If you don't see anything like that, you may need to file the claim yourself.

What should I tell my provider?

Tell them you're enrolled in Aetna Medicare Direct. And let them know not to submit claims to us for supplemental benefits. The claims will be filed automatically.

How do I cancel Aetna Medicare Direct?

If you wish to cancel the Aetna Medicare Direct program, call us at the phone number on your member ID card. Have your Medicare number handy.

Just one more thing ... if your Aetna® medical benefits are canceled, or if Aetna is no longer your secondary carrier, please let us know. Just call the phone number on your member ID card.
